WATCH: Morrow Melts Down as She Fails to Explain Her Calls for Military Coup To Keep Trump in Office

Morrow can't explain her calls for military coup, suggestion that Trump arrest members of Congress for treason and put the Constitution "to the side"

Just days after CNN uncovered a shocking video where Michele Morrow live streamed herself after attending the insurrection on January 6 suggesting that Donald Trump set aside the Constitution, Morrow melts down trying to explain her dangerous viewpoints in an interview with WRAL. <u>Watch the news story here.</u>

Morrow lies to WRAL, trying to deny that she called for the arrest of those who certified the 2020 election, but the video tells the truth. <u>Watch Morrow on January 6 in her own</u> words here. When asked, Morrow stated: "My words were not to arrest people for treason." Those were her exact words. Beforehand, Michele Morrow took her children to the insurrection, and she entered a restricted area of the Capitol.

Here is <u>What Morrow said on January 6</u>, after rioters staged an insurrection at the Capitol trying to stop the peaceful transfer of power: "President Trump is still president until the 20th. So, he can still invoke the executive order against voter fraud, and now

he has every player that participated in his sights, and **they can all be arrested for treason.** And if the police won't do it, and the Department of Justice won't do it, then he will have to enact the Insurrection Act. In which case, the Insurrection Act **completely puts the constitution to the side** and says: **now the military rules all.** Okay, and let me tell you, President Trump. President Trump has the military on his side, because the military and many leaders in the military who love this nation and who love our Constitution and who have put their life on the line to protect the freedoms of people in the United States that they will never meet, they chose President Trump to be their candidate. So as long as he invokes the Insurrection Act before the inauguration, then he's going to be reinaugurated. He's going to be put back in."

"Michele Morrow is dangerous for North Carolina's public schools and students," **said Anderson Clayton, Chair of the North Carolina Democratic Party.** "Morrow calls for political violence when most parents are worried about making their children's schools safer, and she even attended the January 6 insurrection with her own kids. She called on Trump to put the constitution on the side and use the military to stay in office, and then lies about it. She can't be trusted in public office, and she can't be trusted to run our public schools."

"I've spent my career running North Carolina's biggest school districts, and I know what our students need to thrive. We are trying to make our public schools safe places where children have good role models," **said Maurice (Mo) Green, candidate for North Carolina Superintendent of Public Instruction.** "We cannot have a superintendent who calls for military coups, public executions, and political violence. This election goes far beyond political affiliation. Indeed, North Carolinians from across partisan, religious, identity, and geographic lines must come together to meet this moment."

The State Superintendent of Public Instruction serves as the chief administrative officer for North Carolina's public schools, guiding North Carolina's 115 public school districts, more than 2,500 public schools, and over 1.3 million children.
